I hope that the second version of the PC-model from my co-worker Göran Hellström will run on your computer. (The program is not protected.) Don't hesitate to contact us again if it doesn't work or if you find any error. A list of our models available on discs is enclosed.

I am very interested in attending the meeting in Orlando in October of 1988. The period Oct 17-20 is not possible due to the heat storage conference in Paris (JIGASTOCK).

The thermal conductivity of the ground is a major and often uncertain parameter. Your work together with EPRI and Larry Solomon is of great interest. I am quite interested in your results. It would be interesting to have direct field measurement using response tests and perhaps other devices in order to get average values over regions with linear extensions of 0.1 to, say, 10 m.

I personally suspect, contrary to general belief, that the effect of moisture migration on λ is negligible in the present applications. The water content is of course quite important.

I hope that we can keep in contact.
